Development goal(s) shared by IH:	Enabling complete growth (physical, emotional, mental, social and educational) for the deprived women and girl children residing by the side of the railway track of Lake Garden station and the slums at Prince Anwar Shah Road
Project purpose:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> to provide centre based crèche and pre-primary school facility for 50 boys and girls (6 months to 6 years) of working mothers from the slums of Mollahati, Anwar Shah Road and Rail Colony in 2 crèches (Yasmine: 28 children, Bulbuli: 22 children) to continue to provide opportunity for mainstreaming of education to 10 drop out girls through State Level Open schooling system. to provide ICDP training session to 36-40 caregivers of the children to provide psychological support to the mothers who are victim of domestic violence with the aim to modify the child's maladaptive behaviour

Provision of <u>2 crèche facilities</u> for 28 (Yasmine) + 22 (Bulbuli) children of working mothers at the two premises of LGW&CDC with proper safety & security and provision of Joyful learning using Montessori methods for the elder children. 2. Provision of <u>health and nutritional facilities</u> for the 28 + 22 crèche children 3. Provision of <u>educational opportunity</u> to 10 drop out girls (ex trainees and members of SHGs formed by LGW&CDC) of the targeted slums for continuing education through Open Schooling System 4. Provision of <u>training on International Child Development Program (ICDP)</u> to 36 – 40 caregivers (mothers and teachers) of children of 1 year to 11 years 5. Provision of <u>psychological support</u> to the mothers and behavior modification techniques for the children to modify their maladaptive behavior

Open School</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow-up of 10 girls who started Open School in December 2005 • Selection of another 2 subjects for the exams in June 08 and December 08 on consensus basis from the syllabus • Ensure attendance of scheduled classes at study centre at the Adarsha Hindi High School, Tollygunj and Netaji Nagar High School in Netaji Nagar of these 10 students • Provide specialized coaching on the selected subjects (English, Mathematics and Physical Science) for 10 months at LGW&CDC for 10 students • Regular coordination with the study centers for assessment of academic performance <p><u>3. ICDP Training</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introductory meeting with the caregivers in LGW&CDC • Arrangement of 3 training programs (each of 12 sessions with 12-13 participants) with teachers of LGW&CDC and mothers of the children of the center • Home visit to ensure the behavioral improvement of caregivers in child rearing practices • Follow-up meetings with past and present participants • Preparation of an evaluation report for analysis of the training program <p><u>4. Psychological support to the mothers and children (individual counseling)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Helping the educators and mothers to understand the child's behavior • Use of certain behavior modification techniques to change maladaptive behavior of child • Maintenance of separate case history files for individual family and individual child those who are getting the psychological support
